# JUVENILE PLAYERS CHARTER

- Respect fellow team members regardless of ability, cultural or ethnic origin, gender, sexual orientation or religious beliefs.
- Support and positively encourage all team members.
- Be gracious in defeat and modest in victory.
- Shake hands with opponents after every game.
- Take due care of Club equipment.
- Know that it is acceptable to talk to the Club Children's Officer with any concerns or questions they may have.
- Always play by the rules.
- Respect all coaches, officials, team mates or opponents. Accept the decisions of referees and other officials.
- Not use unacceptable language or racial and/or sectarian references to an opponent, a fellow player or official by words, deeds or gesture.
- Not consume non-prescribed drugs or performance enhancing supplements.
- Not use social media to discuss teammates, opponents, coaches, match officials or other individuals.
- Enjoy the game and be the best that YOU can be.



# SENIOR PLAYERS CHARTER

#### Senior Carryduff GAC players should:

- Wear their full Club colours in matches with pride and dignity as befitting the great honour of representing Carryduff GAC.
- Play the game fairly, with due respect for fellow players, match officials, club mentors, and all club property.
- Give respect, get respect.
- Have their membership paid on time. Unpaid players are not eligible to attend training, use Club facilities, and play matches.
- Give full commitment and loyalty to your team and Club when training and playing in matches.
- Wear a gum-shield, helmet for hurling/camogie in training, during all challenge, and competition matches.
- Engage positively with Management Team and Club Officers. Be respectful of decisions of managers and coaches even when you disagree with them.
